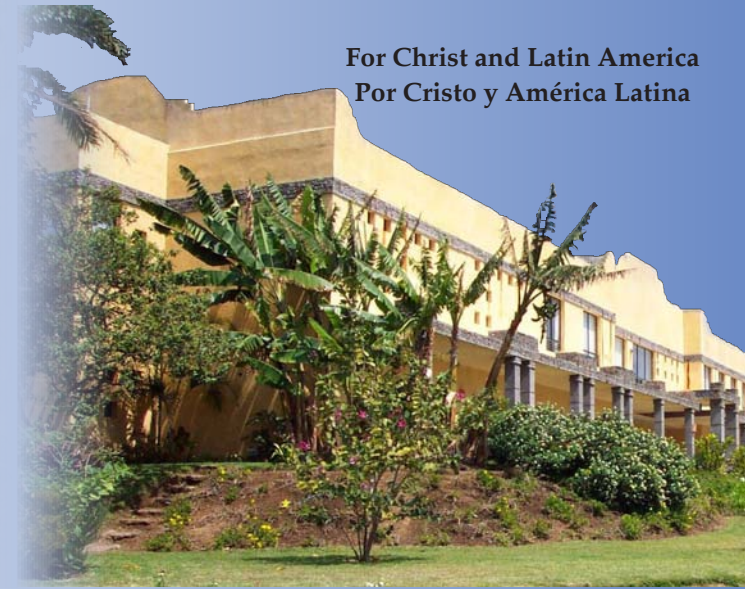

Study Teams

9 to 25 people for 7 to 10 days

Cost per person: \$90 a day, including:

- Airport pickup and delivery
- Local transportation for group activities
- Housing at UBL facilities
- Meals at UBL
- One day of sightseeing
- One meal at a typical restaurant

Activities include:

- Presentations and dialogues with UBL professors and community leaders
- Visit to a community, selected according to your objectives
- One day ecological experience (options include coffee, banana and pineapple plantations, walks in the rain forest, visit a volcano or an archeological site)

Study/Work Combination

9 to 25 people for 7 to 10 days

Cost per person: \$75 a day, including:
